- scams and unsafe behaviour



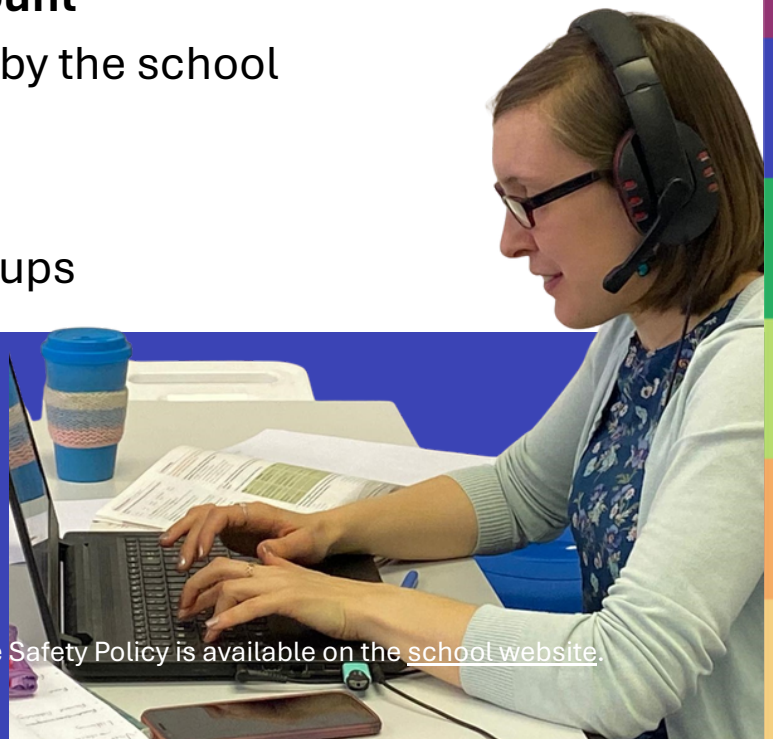
Online Classes and Communication

At IH Manchester:

- classes take place on **official school platforms**
- use your **school email account**
- only join classes scheduled by the school

Do not:

- create your own class links
- join unofficial lessons or groups





Staying Safe Online

When using the internet:

- do not share **personal information**
- be careful who you talk to online
- do not click on unknown links
- protect your passwords

Online risks can include:

- fake information
- scams or fraud
- inappropriate content
- people pretending to be someone else



Online Behaviour

You must:

- be respectful in online classes
- use appropriate language
- follow school rules



Do not:

- send offensive or inappropriate messages
- share harmful or explicit content
- bully others online





➤ Devices and Communication

- Communication with staff is through school systems only
- Staff will not use personal accounts to contact you
- Use school platforms like Teams or Zoom

➤ Reporting Problems

If something makes you feel uncomfortable or unsafe:

- ✦ speak to a **teacher**
- ✦ speak to the **Welfare Manager**
- ✦ speak to the **Principal**

All concerns are taken **seriously and handled privately.**
