Respect and Professional Behaviour

At IH Manchester:

- everyone must treat others with **respect**
- relationships must stay **professional**
- inappropriate behaviour is **not allowed**

This includes:

- offensive comments
- unwanted attention
- inappropriate messages or contact

Online Safety

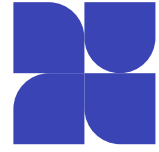
The same rules apply **online**:

- be respectful in online classes
- do not share personal information
- use only school platforms
- do not send inappropriate messages





➤ What Is Not Acceptable?



This behaviour is **not OK**:

- harassment or abuse
- discrimination
- inappropriate relationships
- offensive or sexual comments
- bullying (in person or online)



All concerns are taken **seriously**.

➤ What Should You Do?

If something happens to you or someone else:

 speak to the **Welfare Manager**

 speak to the **Principal**

 speak to a **teacher**

You can talk to us in person or by email.





What Will the School Do?

The school will:

- listen carefully
- take your concern seriously
- act quickly and fairly
- keep information **private**

If needed, action will be taken.



Remember

- You have the **right to feel safe**
- You will be **listened to and supported**
- Reporting a concern will **not get you into trouble**
- It is always right to **ask for help**
